Amendments to AS 4707- Chain of Custody for Forest Products

Amendment 1 September 2016

Enabling Sustainability

The amendment is a correction to the structure and content of the iformal claimî. AS4707:2013 was a direct adoption of PEFC ST 2002:2013, where references to i% PEFC Certifiedî in PEFC ST:2013 were globally changed to i% AFS Certifiedî in AS4707. This created the unforeseen situation where the only allowed claim was in the format of i% AFS Certifiedî. The AFS claim is not recognised in International markets and the standard makes no provision for making a claim to PEFC.

The objective was to make corrections to allow both the ì% AFS Certifiedî and ì% PEFC Certifiedî claims to be made under AS4707.

Amendment 2 April 2018.

The amendment is to provide correction to the requirements for Producer Groups as defined in Appendix Two Clause 2.6 of AS 4707. AS4707:2013 was a direct adoption of PEFC ST 2002:2013 with some local adaptations. In the adoption of PEFC ST 2002:2013, the restriction that producer groups to exist within a single **Country** was changed to exist within a single **State**. This local adaptation was made in AS4707 without any real consideration or technical justification. There is a possibility that by setting a State restriction, that Section 92 of the Australian Constitution defining free trade between states may have been breached.

The amendment replaces the word **State** in Appendix 2-Clause 2.6 with the original **Country** wording.
